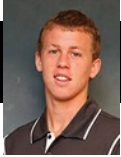

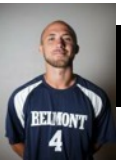

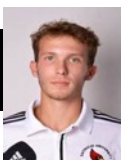
RS Junior - Mid/Def - Belmont University

lou MANNING '09

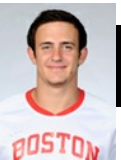
Senior - Keeper - Belmont University

2012: TopDrawerSoccer Preseason Conference Top 20.

2011: Appeared in all 18 games last year recording 1599 minutes, while facing 269 shots and recording 90 saves on the season, letting up 0 goals in 4 of the 18 games. Recorded a season high 9 saves on 10/02/11 vs. USC Upstate in a game resulting in a 0-0 tie. As the primary goal keeper for the Bruins in 2011 he posted a .763 save percentage with a 7-9-2 record.

2010: Appeared in seven games, starting six as goalkeeper...Recorded 554 minutes, while facing 129 shots...Tallied team-bests in goals against average (2.27) and save percentage (.745), the latter was a career-best...Grabbed a season-best 10 saves in 3-2 overtime win at Jacksonville (10/10)...Recorded over 90 minutes in net on two occasions, including 103 at JU.

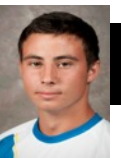

2011: Redshirted due to an injury.



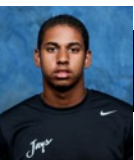
vincent MEDIATE '10

2011 Season: Helped the men's soccer team enjoy its finest season in school history, going 13-6-4, capturing the Colonial Athletic Association Tournament title, and advancing to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for head coach Ian Hennessy • named CAA Tournament Most Valuable Player • named Soccer News National Team of the Week (Nov. 13) • selected SoccerSavings.com/Philly Soccer News College Player of the Week • posted four goals and three assists in 21 games with 18 starts for Delaware.

2010 Season: Logged time in 17 games as a freshman, including 15 starts • started in the final 14 games of the season in the midfield, including the first-ever CAA tournament game for Delaware against No. 12 William & Mary • tallied three points on the season • scored game-winning goal against UNC Wilmington (Oct. 30) and had an assist in his first-ever NCAA game against Canisius (Sept. 3) • took 14 shots during the year, including a career-high three against Towson (Oct. 27) • became the second player in Delaware history to be named to the CAA All-Rookie team • team went 6-9-3 and made first post-season tournament appearance in 14 years.

Westminster College

Horvath graduated from Carroll High School in 2004. Garrett played at Westminster for four years and started his entire career. He was named to the 2008 All-PAC Men's Soccer Team, as voted on by the league's coaches. As a senior at Westminster College, Horvath, also earned first-team all-PAC honors for a consecutive year, tied for second in the PAC with a team-high 12 goals, while also ranking third in points (29), second in points per game (1.38), fourth in assists (5) and third in shots (70).



dom MEDIATE '01

Maryland/Columbus Crew/DC United

Mediate graduated from Carroll High School in 2001 and played club soccer for Dallas Solar. He played college soccer at the University of Maryland making 3 consecutive College Cup appearances. He ended his college career with 27 goals and 17 assists and was named to the All-ACC first team in 2004. Mediate made the Atlantic Coast Conference Academic Honor Roll in 2002 and 2003 and was a four time Academic All-District Men's Soccer team selection.

Mediate was Columbus Crew's second pick (23rd overall) in the 2005 MLS SuperDraft. After a year with the Crew, appearing in 11 games (four starts) with one goal and an assist, he was traded to DC United. Mediate made seven starts for the D.C. Reserves in 2006, scoring a goal and logging two assists. He had worked his way into United's first team, appearing in eight games with two starts when his right leg was broken in a game against LA Galaxy. The injury required surgery and ended his season.

Season-high 86 minutes vs. Furman (9/28/08) ... Assisted on Justin Hay goal at Gardner-Webb for first collegiate point (8/31/08) ... First career goal at Central Arkansas (9/12/08) ... Scored Bruin goal in 1-1 tie at Mercer (10/16/08) ... Assisted on Austin Emby goal in 2-1 victory at Jacksonville (10/31/08) ... Assisted on Dan Meacock goal in Atlantic Sun Quarterfinal victory over Stetson (11/12/08) ... Career-high three shots vs. UNC-Asheville (9/19/09) ... Played into second half in all but one match.
